As of today, the bank balance is \$11,753.65. I had to make several ACH check by phone transactions with Florida Region as we were past due for December in the amount of \$3307.06 and January in the amount of \$2376.56. The literature distribution order for February is in the amount of \$1259.77. ACH checks by phone are still processing and are not reflected in bank statement in the amount of \$5289.86. Leaving a balance due before next ASC \$1653.53 I have access to the treasurers email however I was never sent these invoices. Lili forwarded to my personal email. I have rectified this with region. Deposit was made on 1/13 in the amount of \$1634 the breakdown is reflected on the spreadsheet. Literature in the amount of \$1125.00 and group donations \$509. I collected an additional \$50 that was sent to me via Zelle and will be included in my deposit from last month now totaling \$197.98. Making the Grand total of group donations \$706.98. There are no outstanding checks.

There has been no other reported income. In reconciliation of the spreadsheet vs the bank account I realized I made a reporting error in December and January. I counted the group donations twice. The amount was included in the deposits Lili made. However, she gave me a list of what groups donated. I logged each group donation in order for GSR's to be able to see their group donations. I placed this amount in the income column, but it was included in the bank deposit that I reported as Literature distribution. The amount for December is a \$130 and the amount in January was \$200. The amount of \$10627.60 reported as ending balance in January ASC needs to be corrected to reflect \$10297.60. Our starting balance for February ASC is \$10297.60 with income in the amount of \$1831.98 minus expenses in the amount of \$5619.82 leaving balance of \$6059.73. This is \$13,490.27 below prudent reserves.
