- 2 hybrid meetings currently active

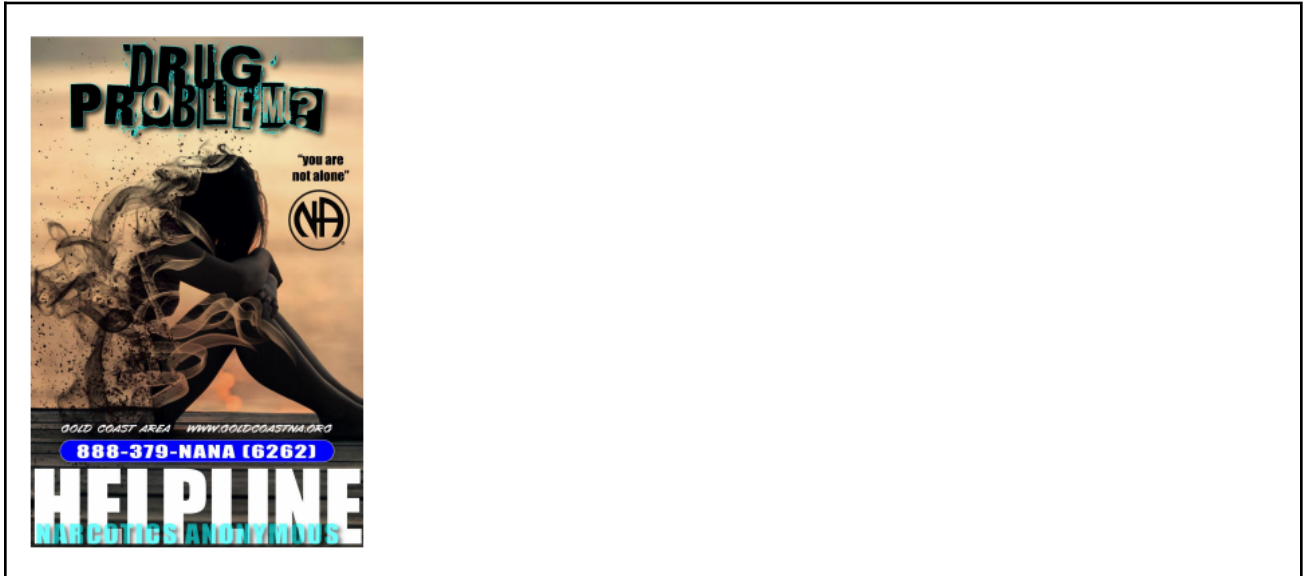
Closing:
