A. PURPOSE The Administrative Committee holds separate, periodic and special committee meetings and carries out the will of the Convention Committee. Its function is to ensure that the various Subcommittees work together and to assist those Subcommittees, however it is not necessary for the Administrative Committee to involve itself directly in the specific workings of each Subcommittee. The members of the Administrative Committee discuss the performance of the Subcommittees as well as the overall budget and other matters which affect the convention. The results of these discussions are included in reports at Convention Committee meetings. The Administrative Committee drafts a schedule of meeting dates for the Convention Committee as soon as possible. This schedule is then approved by the Convention Committee and distributed to all members. It is advisable to choose a night on which meetings will be held and schedule all meetings on that night throughout the duration of the planning period. The Administrative Committee also makes regular reports to the ASC. Comments and suggestions from the ASC are included in the Chairperson's report.

#### 9. RCM REPORT

Good afternoon Gold Coast Area,

The South Florida Region last met on August 20, 2023. Being that our area did not meet quorum on our last scheduled ASC, I did not have any "consciences" (if that is even a word) to bring back to Region. As it turns out, during old business, the "ultimate authority" of our "loving G-D" expressed itself by way of more than simple majority on the motions sent back to groups. Our abstentions in effect did not impact the voting tally.

For anyone interested I'm including an attachment for the RSC Policy Manual.

The attached RSC Policy Manual reflects policy changes approved during the past service cycle. The numbering/ order sections have been updated as many of these were out of sequence.

The RSC Policy Manual is watermarked with "Under Admin Review" because we have determined additional policy changes approved during previous service cycles were not made to the most recent (2022) document. Admin and the MAL are working on this update for the October RSC.

There is a motion to update the SEZF policy manual. This is attached with noted revisions.

Also included is an attachment titled "NA Survival Kit" as presented by our RD.

(WSC) are proposing to bundle this material into one boxed set titled The NA

Survival Kit. For each Step, the Survival Kit would include the section from the Basic Text

chapter "How It Works," the chapter from It Works: How and Why, and the chapter from The

NA Step Working Guides, with the questions numbered rather than bulleted.
