grandfather of 2.5 (one is on the way), these little ones have taught me about unconditional love. I have been an entrepreneur for most of my life, even before I got clean I had my own business. This has taught me about holding a higher context and inspiring others to be their best, not only for themselves but for the company as well. I have overcome a huge weight problem going from 280lbs to 190lbs, through diet and exercise, this has taught me about commitment and discipline. I am a 4 time Ironman triathlon finisher, which has taught me about determination and sacrifice. I have lead an community service based mens organization in Atlanta, being in charge of the coordination efforts of those teams of men to be the men that they have always wanted to be, by mentoring men to live with excellence, and inspiring them to create successful families, careers, and communities.
